Weather this year has been quite the opposite on last year with dry conditions persisting through the month, cold at times in the fresh to strong N/E winds, but having said it's also been very warm and bright when winds have fallen light.

Nevertheless anglers have enjoyed the mix for weather during the month perhaps a little too bright on a number of days for fishing making catching more difficult. The latest forecast is that this weather will continue into June.
